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1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §17A-3-14g of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended,
2 relating to the issuance of special plates to recipients of the Distinguished Medal of Valor
3 or their surviving spouse; providing for plate design by Division of Motor Vehicles;
4 specifying fees; exempting certain individuals from registration fees; and providing
5 application and qualification requirements.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

**ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF
CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.**

§17A-3-14g. Special registration plates for first responders.

1 (a) The division may issue special emergency or volunteer registration plates as follows:

2 (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the state of West Virginia and who
3 is a certified paramedic or emergency medical technician, member of a paid fire department,
4 member of the State Fire Commission, the State Fire Marshal, State Fire Marshal assistant, State
5 Fire Administrator, or voluntary rescue squad member may apply for a special license plate for
6 any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant which bears the
7 insignia of the profession, group, or commission. Any insignia shall be designed by the
8 commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subsection shall bear the requested insignia
9 in addition to the registration number issued to the applicant pursuant to the provisions of this
10 article.

11 (2) Each application submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be accompanied by an
12 affidavit signed by the fire chief or department head of the applicant stating that the applicant is
13 justified in having a registration with the requested insignia, proof of compliance with all laws of
14 this state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles, and payment of all required fees.

15 (3) Each application submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be accompanied by
16 payment of a special initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to all other fees required by

17 this chapter. All special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited into the State Road
18 Fund.

19 (b) The division may issue special certified firefighter registration plates as follows:

20 (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the state of West Virginia and who
21 is a certified firefighter may apply for a special license plate that bears the insignia of the
22 profession for any number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant. Any
23 insignia shall be designed by the commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to this subsection
24 shall bear the requested insignia pursuant to the provisions of this article. Upon presentation of
25 written evidence of certification as a certified firefighter, certified firefighters are eligible to
26 purchase the special registration plate issued pursuant to this subsection.

27 (2) Each application submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be accompanied by an
28 affidavit stating that the applicant is justified in having a registration with the requested insignia,
29 proof of compliance with all laws of this state regarding registration and licensure of motor
30 vehicles, and payment of all required fees. The firefighter certification department, section, or
31 division of the West Virginia University fire service extension shall notify the commissioner in
32 writing immediately when a firefighter loses his or her certification. If a firefighter loses his or her
33 certification, the commissioner may not issue him or her a license plate under this subsection.

34 (3) Each application submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be accompanied by
35 payment of a special initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to all other fees required by
36 this chapter. All special fees shall be collected by the division and deposited into the State Road
37 Fund.

38 (c) The division may issue special volunteer firefighter registration plates as follows:

39 (1) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of West Virginia and who is a volunteer
40 firefighter may apply for a special license plate for any Class A vehicle titled in the name of the
41 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profession in white letters on a red background.

42 The insignia shall be designed by the commissioner and shall contain a fireman's helmet insignia
43 on the left side of the license plate.

44 (2) Each application submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be accompanied by an
45 affidavit signed by the applicant's fire chief, stating that the applicant is a volunteer firefighter and
46 is justified in having a registration plate with the requested insignia. The applicant must comply
47 with all other laws of this state regarding registration and licensure of motor vehicles and must
48 pay all required fees.

49 (3) Each application submitted pursuant to this subsection shall be accompanied by
50 payment of a special one-time initial application fee of \$10, which is in addition to all other fees
51 required by this chapter. All application fees shall be deposited into the State Road Fund.

52 (d) The division may issue special registration plates to applicants supporting law-
53 enforcement officers, to retired members of the West Virginia State Police, and to survivors of
54 wounds received in the line of duty as a member with a West Virginia law-enforcement agency
55 as follows:

56 (1) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue a special registration plate
57 designed by the commissioner which recognizes, supports, and honors the men and women of
58 law-enforcement and includes the words "Back the Blue". Upon appropriate application, the
59 division shall issue to any member of a municipal police department, sheriff's department, the
60 State Police, or the law-enforcement division of the Division of Natural Resources who has been
61 wounded in the line of duty and awarded a Purple Heart in recognition thereof by the West Virginia
62 Chiefs of Police Association, the West Virginia Sheriffs' Association, the West Virginia Troopers
63 Association, or the Division of Natural Resources a special registration plate for one vehicle titled
64 in the name of the qualified applicant with an insignia appropriately designed by the
65 commissioner.

66 (2) For special registration plates supporting law-enforcement officers, the division shall
67 charge a special initial application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

68 This special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road Fund. An
69 annual fee of \$15 shall be charged for each plate supporting law-enforcement officers in addition
70 to all other fees required by this chapter.

71 (3) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subsection to survivors of wounds received
72 in the line of duty as a member with a West Virginia law-enforcement agency are exempt from
73 the registration fees otherwise required by the provisions of this chapter. A surviving spouse may
74 continue to use his or her deceased spouse's special registration plate until the surviving spouse
75 dies, remarries, or does not renew the plate. Survivors of wounds received in the line of duty as
76 a member with a West Virginia law-enforcement agency may obtain a license plate as described
77 in this subsection for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The
78 division shall charge for the second plate a one-time fee of \$10, to be deposited into the State
79 Road Fund, which is in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.

80 (4) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue special registration plates
81 designed by the commissioner for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified
82 applicant who offers sufficient proof of being a retired member of the West Virginia State Police.
83 The division shall charge a special initial application fee of \$10 in addition to all other fees required
84 by this chapter. This special fee shall be collected by the division and deposited in the State Road
85 Fund.

86 (e) The division may issue special plates with an insignia appropriately designed by the
87 commissioner to recipients of the distinguished Medal of Valor awarded under §29-32-1 *et seq.*
88 of this code to firefighters, law-enforcement officers, and emergency medical services personnel
89 who distinguish themselves conspicuously by gallantry and intrepidity at the risk of their lives
90 above and beyond the call of duty in the performance of their duties as follows:

91 (1) Any Medal of Valor recipient under §29-32-1 *et seq.* of this code or their surviving
92 spouse may apply to receive the special registration plate issued pursuant to this subsection for
93 any Class A vehicle titled in the name of the Medal of Valor recipient or their surviving spouse.

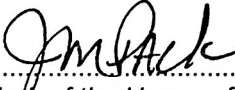
94 (2) The applicant shall present satisfactory proof as determined by the commissioner as
95 evidence of qualification for any plate authorized in this subsection. A surviving spouse may
96 continue to use the license plate of his or her deceased spouse that was issued pursuant to this
97 subsection until the surviving spouse dies, remarries, or does not renew the license plate.

98 (3) A qualified applicant as provided in paragraph (1) of this subsection may apply for a
99 second license plate as described in this subsection for use on a Class A vehicle titled in the
100 name of the qualified applicant.

101 (4) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subsection to qualified applicants are
102 exempt from the registration fees otherwise required by the provisions of this chapter. A qualified
103 applicant may obtain a license plate as described in this subsection for use on a passenger vehicle
104 titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge for the second plate a one-
105 time fee of \$10, to be deposited into the State Road Fund, which is in addition to all other fees
106 required by this chapter.

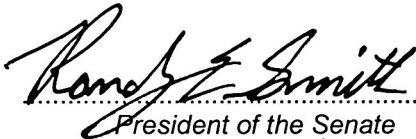

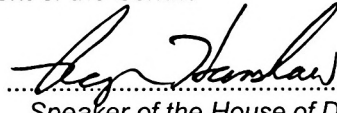
